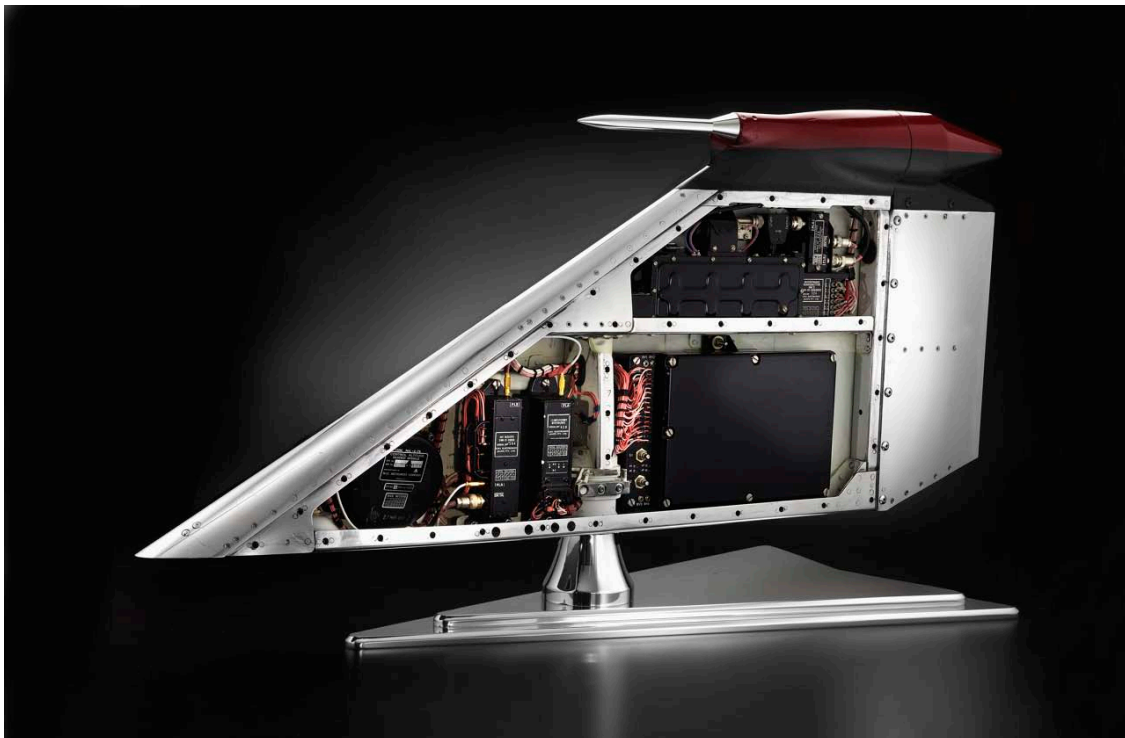


COLD WAR-NUCLEAR ERA COLLECTORS SERIES (1950-60'S)

This Martin Baker Mark 2 was fitted in a British Electric “Camberra” Nuclear Bomber.
